EMERGENCY CARD INFORMATION

In accordance with Rising Stars Academy Policies, for the protection of our students' health and welfare, it is a requirement that parents or legal guardians keep current emergency information at the academy. The emergency information will include: the parent or guardian's home address, parents emergency contact phone telephone number(s) and contact phone number(s) of a relative or friend who is authorized to care for the student(s) in any emergency situation if the parent or legal guardian cannot be reached. We would appreciate you taking the time to fill out your child(ren)'s current emergency information for care. Please include at least three (3) different telephone numbers and names of responsible persons to contact. Please return this information to Rising Stars Academy immediately. We are requesting that you inform Rising Stars Academy whenever this information changes.

ATTENDANCE AND ABSENCE POLICY

Establishing good attendance and punctuality is important. These habits have a lifelong value. Please monitor the time your child goes to bed so that he or she will be well rested and ready to learn. When your child returns to school after an absence of one day or more, as a courtesy send a note explaining the reason and give it to the child's teacher (more than 3 days requires a doctor's note, if prior vacation was not approved).

SCHOOL UNIFORMS AND STUDENT DRESS STANDARDS

^{*}Children who arrive after 8:30 a.m. will not be served breakfast. If a parent is late, it is advised that they stop to get breakfast for their child(ren) before coming to school.
